

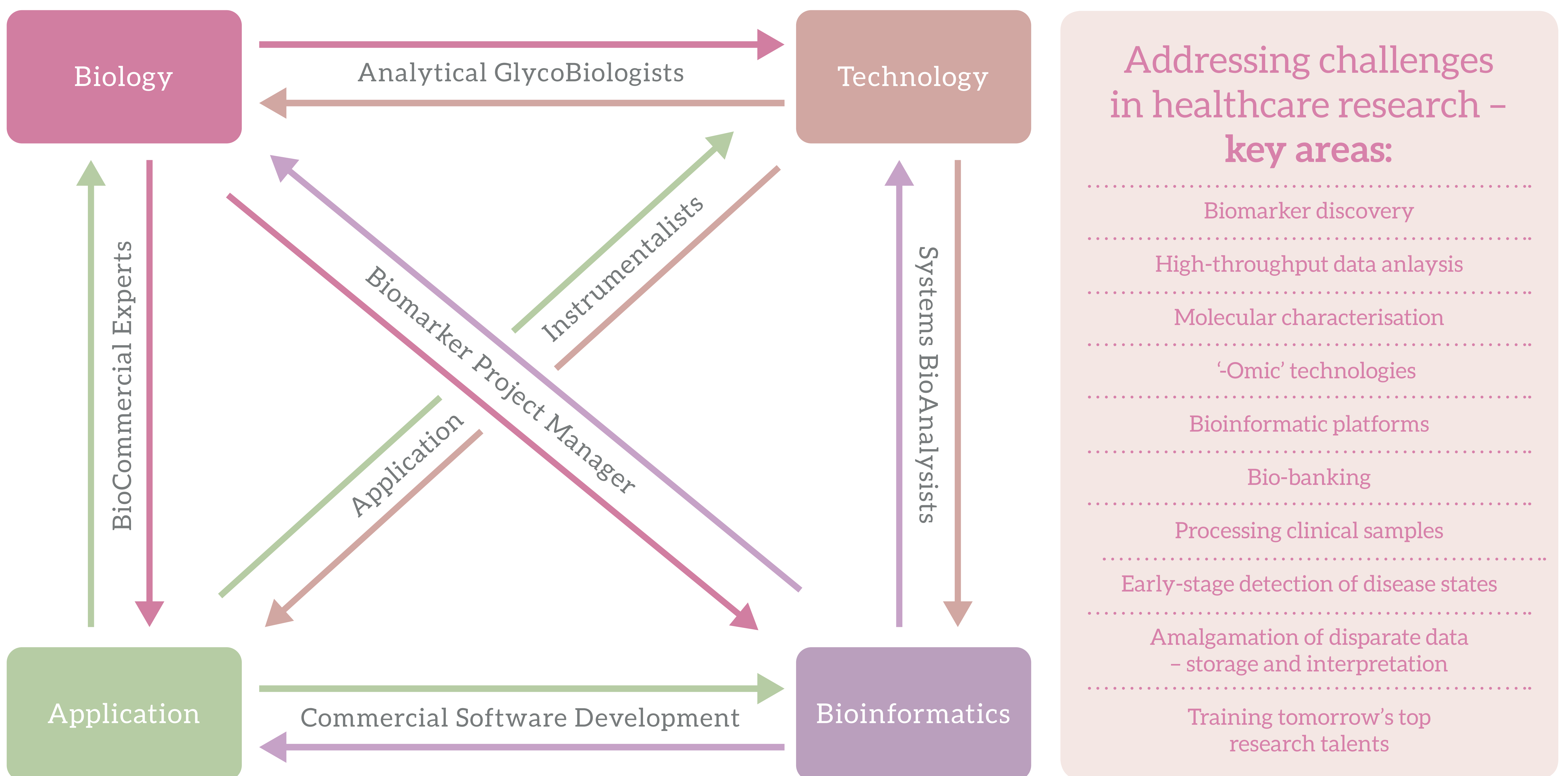


Gastric Glyco Explorer

Initial Training Network of the EU Seventh Framework Programme (FP7)
Official launch 1 May 2013

Objective: GGE will set up a training and research network to address gastric cancer. To achieve this, existing infrastructure in the ‘-omics’ area will be improved by integrating glyco-analytical platforms with bioinformatic resources across Europe.
